The next lecture of the 1916 Committee will be on February 7th at the Ceilidhe Club. The start time is 7:30.

The 1916 Committee and before them the RI Unit of Irish Northern Aid have been strong proponents of a United Ireland. Of course, many generations of Irishmen and women have fought and died for that same objective. The long. tragic history of Ireland struggling for its independence from England has been the topic of many of our monthly lectures. While it is important that we remember and reflect on the Fenian Rebellion of 1798, the Penal Laws, the Famine, the suppression of the Irish language, culture, religion, along with the Cromwell massacres, the Catalpa rescue, the Easter Rising, the two Bloody Sundays, the Troubles, the Hunger Strikes, the GFA, and the countless other major and minor acts of resistance to colonial occupation, we must also look forward to seeing these aspirations realized. The Rising and War of Independence period presented the greatest opportunity for independence. But of course, the gerrymandered partition forced by the British ended that opportunity. And now a little more than a hundred years later Ireland remains divided.

But due to a strange confluence of circumstances, it seems a very real possibility of unity exists today. Admittedly this path forward will be very difficult and will require a great amount of work. It is apparent that there is momentum in Ireland and North America to seize this time. Some of our members will be traveling to conferences in both DC and Rockland County NY on January 27 and 30th to participate with the Commission on the Future of Ireland - which will be a conversation with the diaspora, the descendants of Ireland and all those who support Irish unity. These conferences are sponsored by Friends of Sinn Fein.

The lecture on the 7th will be a panel discussion of the committee members who attended and they will present ideas and suggestions for the road forward.
